The Student Card is the multi-service card, created in collaboration with Crédit Agricole Italia, dedicated to students in the University of Parma.

Carry out main **banking operations, including**: paying **university fees**, **rent** and **utilities**, making phone top-ups and **purchases**, also **online**





PROGRAMME OF STUDY (Piano degli studi)

Where to find it

- Choices must be made annually, according to preset windows:
- First window: from Monday November 11th to Friday 31st January
- Second window: from Monday March 10th to Thursday May 15th
- <u>Study Program Presentation</u>
- Class work: attendance and participation in course activities (project work, group work, etc.) are strongly recommended
- Final questionnaire: your opinion is important. At the end of each course, fill in the questionnaire very carefully.



LANGUAGES

IBD requirement (English):

- By September 2025, one of the <u>these</u> certifications is required
- Students who do not obtain a certificate by September 2025 can not take second-year exams.

For international exchanges (Overworld, Erasmus+,...)

<u>LPT (Language Placement Test),</u> internal test, compulsory to apply for international exchanges

→ An English test is usually not required to IBD students going abroad for international exchanges. Other languages might be required, depending on the receiving country. → always check the call!

General principle: the sooner the better



INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGES

Erasmus+ and **Overworld** programs:

Bilateral exchange agreements, including extra-EU countries, scholarships available:

Argentina, Brazil, USA, Japan, Vietnam, India, China, Thailand, Turkey, Georgia, Russia, Oman, Tanzania, Senegal.

Erasmus+ and Overwold are in the same call.

Double degrees

Vilnius University (Lithuania): 1 semester

Bochum University (Germany): 1 year

Grenoble Ecole de Management (France): 1 year

FECAP (Sao Paulo – BRA)






FINAL DISSERTATION


